

Kathryn Aguirre Worth Memorial Scholarship

The Scholarship was established to honour the memory of Kathryn Aguirre Worth, an American attorney with White & Case LLP, who was on board the ill-fated Silk Air flight MI 185 on 19 December 1997. This scholarship is funded by the Kathryn Aguirre Worth Memorial Foundation.

Terms of the Award. The scholarship will provide a stipend of up to US\$25,000 to defray tuition fees for graduate studies at a US law school. The award excludes general expenses.

Eligibility. The scholarship to be awarded in 2021 is open to NUS LLB graduates from the classes of 2014 to 2020 who will pursue an LLM degree at an accredited law school in the United States.
